What is a Certified Pro-Nox™ Comfort Zone?

What is Pro-Nox™?

Pro-Nox™ is a proven, safe analgesic gas delivery system that utilizes a 50/50 mix of Nitrous Oxide and Oxygen. In simpler terms, Pro-Nox™ is comparable to “laughing gas” because it relieves treatment pain, stress, anxiety, and overall discomfort by safely inducing a more relaxed and euphoric state of being.

How does it work?

Pro-Nox™ is inhaled using interchangeable breathing circuits, ensuring complete protection against germs and other viral bacteria.

YOU are in complete control when using Pro-Nox™. The Pro-Nox™ on-demand valve allows for 100% self-administration, ensuring maximum safety for patients and staff — you inhale however much you need based on how much relief you need from pain or anxiety. This practice is a Pro-Nox™ Comfort Zone, staffed with specially trained professionals who will guide you through the inhalation process. PRO TIP: Use the nose clip for best results.

Is Pro-Nox™ safe?

Yes! Pro-Nox™ is FDA cleared and the most trusted pain management solution for over 8,000 offices in the United States and Canada! It has been used by millions of patients. Unlike anesthesia, Pro-Nox™ does NOT cause patients to “go under” or to fall into complete sedation. Instead, its analgesia elicits temporary pain relief without losing total consciousness and without losing your sense of feeling, and/or movement during your procedure.

In fact, Pro-Nox™ has been a popular, trusted addition for use in labor and delivery. Since it is safe for mothers and their unborn children, then you can rest assured that Pro-Nox™ is safe for you!

What does Pro-Nox™ feel like?
